
Comparison of the emotional trajectory of Moby Dick with the results for three example randomized



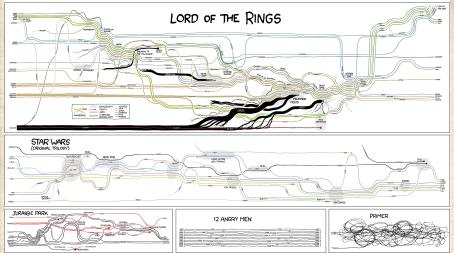


